

# Rebound PASS™ Program

The **Positive Alternative to Suspension from School** program provides an alternative to home suspension for youth in Grades 7 through 12.



## How does the program work?

The PASS program provides academic support to students through one-on-one tutoring, supervised homework support and access to teaching resources. While suspended, students attend the program, where trained staff help them develop positive social and cognitive skills and help keep students from falling behind on their schoolwork.

### What is required of the students?

Students bring school materials and assignments from school and participate in skills training recommended by program staff.

### What is required of the schools?

School principals gain written consent from the student's parent/guardian. Schools will also provide sufficient academic materials to ensure students progress in their studies at their class rate.

### What is required of the parent/ guardian?

Parents sign a consent form and arrange transportation for their child to attend the program. Parents provide input into any assessment procedures and complete follow-up evaluation feedback on the program.

### Is the program successful?

More than 78 per cent of the youth in the program reported that PASS helped them deal with the reasons they were suspended, while 93 per cent said they were more likely to think about the consequences of their actions. Another 90 per cent of parents stated the program helped their children deal with the reasons for suspension.
